Here are more details on the RSDL tournament.

Medical Release Forms:

Forms need to be completed and handed to me on THURSDAY the 8th. NO form NO play

Game schedule:

If you are in the tournament, then you have NO regular RSDL game on Saturday morning

The game schedule and team roster is posted on the RYSL web site. 'RSDL – Tournaments'. Check the roster and make sure your name is on there if you asked to play

Know the name of your coach for the tournament

Be at your game field 20 mins before the stated kick off time

Game format is 6 v6. Goalkeeper plus 5 field players. 25 minute half's

Parents are opposite the players on the sidelines

Items to bring:

Your RSDL uniform: Both Navy and White jerseys, Navy shorts and Navy socks. I suggest additional socks just in case they get wet

Bring a towel

Bring a large garbage bag to put wet clothes and shoes in

Bring a change of clothing for your kid, so that can change before the drive home

Bring a chair

Bring an umbrella

Size 4 soccer ball

Plenty of water

Laws of the game:

The tournament plays by FIFA laws and not the RSDL laws, they are similar but with a few changes.

Throw ins: Players must throw the ball in from the touchline. Both hands must be on the ball and the ball must be thrown from behind the head.

Goalkeeper can punt the ball: The ball can travel over half way, however it cannot go directly into the opposition's penalty area.

Pass backs to the goalkeeper: I cannot find anything on this so I am assuming that this is allowed. I will confirm.

Slide Tackling: Is NOT ALLOWED

The Tournament:

This is a recreational tournament only. Neither scores nor stats are recorded. Each team will play three games regardless.

RSDL Coaches:

All coaches must be in attendance at all games

All coaches must wear their RYSL member pass and Risk Management Card. No card no pay!

All coaches must bring a first aid kit complete with ice packs

Bring a few bibs for the goalies. I will try and get GK jerseys, but just in case I forget

Parents:

It is your kids' time to experience playing in a competitive tournament. Please let them play, please let them have fun, please let them learn on their own

Sideline behavior will be on the same guidelines as that of the RSDL. Scream and shout as loud as you want for what the kids have done and not for what they are about to do!

Do not coach from the sidelines
